The Law of the Righteousness of God

God is Righteous:

Psalms 145:17 The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.

Psalms 116:5 Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful.

Psalms 7:9 Oh let the <u>wickedness</u> of the <u>wicked</u> come to an end; but establish the just: for the <u>righteous</u> God trieth the hearts and reins.

Exodus 9:27 And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, <u>I have</u> sinned this time: the LORD is <u>righteous</u>, and <u>I and my people are wicked</u>.

1 Samuel 12:7 Now therefore stand still, that I may reason with you before the LORD of all the righteous acts of the LORD, which he did to you and to your fathers.

Daniel 9:14 Therefore hath the LORD <u>watched upon the evil</u>, and brought it upon us: for the LORD our God *is* <u>righteous</u> in <u>all his works which he doeth</u>: for <u>we obeyed not his voice</u>.

The Law is Righteous:

Deuteronomy 4:8 (KJV) And what nation is there so great, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 13:18 (KJV) When thou shalt hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep all his commandments which I command thee this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 33:19 (KJV) They shall call the people unto the mountain; there they shall offer sacrifices of righteousness: for they shall suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hid in the sand.

Psalms 19:8 (KJV) The <u>statutes</u> of the LORD <u>are right</u>, rejoicing the heart: the <u>commandment</u> of the LORD <u>is pure</u>, enlightening the eyes.

Psalms 19:9 The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring for ever: the <u>judgments</u> of the LORD *are* true and <u>righteous</u> altogether.

Psalms 33:4 (KJV) For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.

Psalms 119:128 (KJV) Therefore I esteem all thy <u>precepts</u> concerning all things to be <u>right</u>; and <u>I</u> hate every false way.

Psalms 119:137-138 (KJV) TZADDI. Righteous art thou, O LORD, and <u>upright</u> are thy judgments. 138 Thy <u>testimonies</u> that thou hast commanded are <u>righteous</u> and very faithful.

Psalms 119:144 (KJV) The <u>righteousness</u> of thy <u>testimonies</u> is everlasting: give me understanding, and I shall live.

Psalms 119:160 (KJV) Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy <u>righteous</u> judgments endureth for ever.

Psalms 119:172 (KJV) My tongue shall speak of <u>thy word</u>: for <u>all thy commandments</u> are <u>righteousness</u>.

Isaiah 48:18 (KJV) O that thou hadst hearkened to <u>my commandments</u>! then had thy peace been as a river, and <u>thy righteousness</u> as the waves of the sea:

Isaiah 58:2 (KJV) Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know <u>my ways</u>, as a nation that <u>did</u> <u>righteousness</u>, and <u>forsook not the <u>ordinance of their God</u>: they ask of me the <u>ordinances of justice</u>; they take delight in approaching to God.</u>

Ezekiel 18:9 (KJV) <u>Hath walked in my statutes</u>, and hath kept <u>my judgments</u>, to deal truly; <u>he is just</u>, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

The **Subject** of Israel's Righteousness was the LORD:

Exodus 20:1-5 And God spake all these words, saying, 2 I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: 5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

Deuteronomy 6:1-6 (KJV) Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it: **2** That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. **3** Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey. **4** Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: **5** And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. **6** And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

The **Object** (Means) of Israel's Righteousness Was the Law:

Exodus 19:4-8 Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and *how* I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself. **5** Now therefore, <u>if</u> ye will <u>obey my voice</u> indeed, and <u>keep my covenant</u>, <u>then</u> ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine: **6** And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* <u>the words</u> which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel. **7** And Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before their faces all these words which the LORD commanded him. **8** And all the people answered together, and said, <u>All</u> that the LORD hath spoken we will <u>do</u>. And Moses returned the words of the people unto the LORD.

Deuteronomy 6:1-6 (KJV) Now these are <u>the commandments</u>, <u>the statutes</u>, and <u>the judgments</u>, which the LORD your God commanded <u>to teach you</u>, that <u>ye might do them</u> in the land whither ye go to possess it: **2** That <u>thou mightest fear the LORD thy God</u>, to <u>keep all his statutes</u> and <u>his commandments</u>, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. **3** Hear therefore, O Israel, and <u>observe to do it</u>; that it

may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey. **4** Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: **5** And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with <u>all thine heart</u>, and with <u>all thy soul</u>, and with <u>all thy might</u>. **6** And <u>these words</u>, <u>which I command thee this day</u>, shall be in <u>thine heart</u>:

Deuteronomy 6:24-25 (KJV) And the LORD <u>commanded us to do all these statutes</u>, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as it is at this day. **25** And it shall be <u>our righteousness</u>, if <u>we</u> observe to <u>do all these commandments</u> before the LORD our God, as he hath <u>commanded us</u>.

Deuteronomy 30:15-16 (KJV) See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil; **16** In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to <u>walk in his ways</u>, and <u>to</u> <u>keep his commandments</u> and <u>his statutes</u> and <u>his judgments</u>, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Leviticus 18:1-5 (KJV) And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, **2** Speak unto the <u>children</u> of Israel, and say unto <u>them</u>, I am the LORD your God. **3** After the <u>doings</u> of the land of Egypt, wherein <u>ye</u> dwelt, shall <u>ye</u> not do: and after the <u>doings</u> of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall <u>ye</u> not do: <u>neither</u> shall <u>ye</u> walk in their ordinances. **4** Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I am the LORD your God. **5** Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I am the LORD.

The **Object** (Means) of an Individual's Righteousness Was the Law:

Romans 2:13 (KJV) (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, <u>but the doers of the law</u> <u>shall be justified</u>.

1 Samuel 26:23 (KJV) The <u>LORD render to every man his righteousness</u> and <u>his faithfulness</u>: for the LORD delivered thee into my hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed.

2 Samuel 22:21 (KJV) The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness: according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.

2 Samuel 22:25 (KJV) Therefore the <u>LORD hath recompensed me according</u> to <u>my righteousness</u>; according to <u>my cleanness</u> in <u>his eye sight</u>.

1 Kings 8:32 (KJV) Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness.

Psalms 7:8 (KJV) The <u>LORD shall judge the people</u>: judge me, O LORD, according to <u>my</u> <u>righteousness</u>, and according to <u>mine integrity</u> that <u>is in me</u>.

Psalms 15:1-2 (KJV) LORD, <u>who</u> shall abide in thy tabernacle? <u>who</u> shall dwell in thy holy hill? **2** <u>He</u> that <u>walketh uprightly</u>, and <u>worketh righteousness</u>, and <u>speaketh the truth in <u>his</u> heart.</u>

Psalms 18:20 (KJV) The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.

Psalms 18:24 (KJV) Therefore hath the <u>LORD recompensed me according</u> to <u>my righteousness</u>, according to the <u>cleanness of my hands</u> in <u>his eyesight</u>.

Psalms 106:3 (KJV) Blessed are <u>they</u> that keep <u>judgment</u>, and <u>he</u> that doeth <u>righteousness</u> at all times.

Psalms 106:30-31 (KJV) Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment: and so the plague was stayed. **31** And <u>that was counted unto him for righteousness</u> unto all generations for evermore.

Proverbs 11:6 (KJV) The <u>righteousness</u> of the <u>upright</u> shall deliver <u>them</u>: but transgressors shall be taken in their own naughtiness.

Ezekiel 3:16-19 (KJV) And it came to pass at the end of seven days, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, **17** Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. **18** When I say unto the wicked, <u>Thou</u> shalt surely die; and thou givest <u>him</u> not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from <u>his</u> wicked way, to save <u>his</u> life; the same wicked <u>man</u> shall die in <u>his</u> iniquity; but <u>his</u> blood will I require at thine hand. **19** Yet if thou warn the wicked, and <u>he</u> turn not from <u>his</u> wicked way, <u>he</u> shall die in <u>his</u> iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul.

Ezekiel 3:20 (KJV) Again, When a righteous <u>man</u> doth turn from <u>his</u> righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before <u>him</u>, <u>he</u> shall die: because thou hast not given <u>him</u> warning, <u>he</u> shall die in <u>his</u> sin, and <u>his</u> righteousness which <u>he</u> hath done shall not be remembered; but <u>his</u> blood will I require at thine hand.

Ezekiel 14:14 (KJV) Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, <u>they</u> should deliver but <u>their own souls</u> by <u>their</u> righteousness, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 14:20 (KJV) Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, <u>they</u> shall deliver neither son nor daughter; <u>they</u> shall but deliver their own souls by <u>their</u> righteousness.

Ezekiel 18:19-27 (KJV) Yet say ye, Why? doth not the son bear the iniquity of the father? When the son hath done that which is lawful and right, and hath kept all my statutes, and hath done them, he shall surely live. 20 The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him. 21 But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die. 22 All his transgressions that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live. 23 Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live? 24 But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die. 25 Yet ye say, The way of the Lord is not equal. Hear now, O house of Israel; Is not my way equal? are not your ways unequal? **26** When a righteous man turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and dieth in them; for his iniquity that he hath done shall he die. 27 Again, when the wicked man turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive.

Ezekiel 33:12-19 (KJV) Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the <u>righteous</u> shall not deliver <u>him</u> in the day of <u>his</u> transgression: as for the wickedness of the <u>wicked</u>, <u>he</u> shall not fall thereby in the day that <u>he</u> turneth from <u>his</u> wickedness; neither shall the <u>righteous</u> be able to live for <u>his</u> righteousness in the day that <u>he</u> sinneth. **13** When I shall say to the <u>righteous</u>, that he shall surely live; if he trust to <u>his own</u> righteousness, and commit iniquity, all <u>his</u> righteousnesses shall not be remembered; but for <u>his</u> iniquity that he hath committed, <u>he</u> shall die for it. **14** Again, when I say unto the <u>wicked</u>, <u>Thou</u> shalt surely die; if <u>he</u> turn from <u>his</u> sin, and do that which is lawful and right; **15** If the <u>wicked</u> restore the pledge, give again that <u>he</u> had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committed shall be mentioned unto <u>him</u>: <u>he</u> hath done that which is <u>lawful</u> and <u>right</u>; <u>he</u> shall surely live. **17** Yet the children of thy people say, The way of the Lord is not equal: but as for them, their way is not equal. **18** When the <u>righteous</u> turneth from <u>his</u> righteousness, and committeth iniquity, <u>he</u> shall even die thereby. **19** But if the <u>wicked</u> turn from <u>his</u> wickedness, and do that which is <u>lawful</u> and <u>right</u>; <u>he</u> shall even die thereby.

Luke 1:5-6 (KJV) There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisabeth. 6 And they were both <u>righteous before God</u>, walking in all the <u>commandments</u> and <u>ordinances</u> of the Lord <u>blameless</u>.

Matthew 5:20 (KJV) For I say unto <u>you</u>. That except <u>your righteousness</u> shall exceed the <u>righteousness of the scribes</u> and <u>Pharisees</u>, <u>ye</u> shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 23:1-3 (KJV) Then spake Jesus to the <u>multitude</u>, and to <u>his disciples</u>, **2** Saying, The <u>scribes</u> and the <u>Pharisees</u> sit in <u>Moses' seat</u>: **3** All therefore whatsoever <u>they</u> bid <u>you observe</u>, that <u>observe</u> and <u>do</u>; but <u>do not ye</u> after <u>their</u> works: for <u>they</u> say, and <u>do not</u>.

The <u>Method</u> in Obtaining the Righteousness of the Law was By Faith (Faithful Obedience):

Romans 10:5 (KJV) For Moses describeth the <u>righteousness which is of the law</u>. That the man which doeth those things shall <u>live by them</u>.

Habakkuk 2:4 (KJV) Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Ezekiel 18:8-9 (KJV) He *that* hath not given forth upon usury, neither hath taken any increase, *that* hath withdrawn his hand from iniquity, hath executed true judgment between man and man, **9** Hath <u>walked</u> <u>in my statutes</u>, and hath <u>kept my judgments</u>, to <u>deal truly</u>; <u>he *is* just</u>, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

Deuteronomy 6:5-6 (KJV) And thou shalt <u>love the LORD thy God</u> with <u>all thine heart</u>, and with <u>all thy soul</u>, and with <u>all thy might</u>. **6** And <u>these words</u>, <u>which I command thee this day</u>, shall be in <u>thine heart</u>:

Romans 9:31-32 But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. **32** Wherefore? Because <u>they sought it not by faith</u>, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;
