1Co 7:6 Paul discusses marriage	6 But I speak this by permission, and not of commandment .
1Co 7:25 Reasons for marrying or remaining single	25 Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that hath obtained mercy of the Lord to be faithful.
2Co 8:8 He urges the Corinthians to be liberal	8 I speak not by commandment , but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love.
Tit 1:3 Why Titus was left in Crete	3 But hath in due times manifested his word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;
1Ti 1:1 Timothy is reminded of the charge Paul gave him as the apostle left for Macedonia	1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope;
1Co 14:37 Women are forbidden to speak in church	37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.
1Th 4:2 He exhorts them to please God in their lives, and especially to value purity	2 For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.
Ro 16:26 and, after various salutations, ends with praise and thanks to God	26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:
1Ti 6:14 Godliness is great gain	14 That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:
Ro 13:9 Subjection to magistrates and other duties we owe them	9 For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment , it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
1Co 7:19 Marriage vows are to be taken seriously	19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.
1Ti 1:5 Of the right use and purpose of the law	5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:
